ANNUAL REPORT 2020-21

- Introduction

The academic session 2020-21 started following Covid-19 guidelines strictly. The college is a co-educational, multi faculty minority College. So the admission process was conducted offline. The total admissions in the arts, Commerce, Biology, Maths, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Computer Sc., Home Sc. Streams of UG classes and Chemistry and Botany streams of PG classes were 857.

- Staff

The total teaching staff consists of 27 members including 17 non-teaching staff. In addition to it, the campus maintenance staff comprises of 16 members in which 12 women employees, 2 men and 2 supervisors.

- Online Classes

The classes were started from 1st October, 2020 in online mode due to Covid-19 and continued till 31st December. The offline classes started from 1st Jan. to 15th March, 2021.

In the beginning of the session, a college visit was arranged for the students of I<sup>st</sup> year classes so they can have an introduction of the office, various laboratories, library etc.

- CCE Assignments & Practicals

During the online classes CCE and other assignments were given to the students which they could complete at home without violating pandemic guidelines. The practical examinations and theory examinations were completed according to the directions and guidelines of M.P. Higher education department and DAVV, Indore.

- Extra curricular activities

Various activities like games & sports, cultural activities, Ankur Yojana and programmes under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav were performed according to the academic calendar of DAVV.

Karate training for girls as part of women's empowerment program.

The students were given online & offline counselling under NSS, Redcross society & Vivekanand career guidance.

The students were also given suggestions about career placement drives, competitive exams etc.

- Research Projects

The college got two research projects from M.P. state Biodiversity Board Bhopal (M.P.) with financial aid at PBR Burhanpur and Khaknar both of the projects were submitted in the given time limits.

Two more projects are in progress under the M.P. Govt. Biodiversity Department which are at PBR Burhanpur and PBR Neapanagar.

For the coming session three more projects are proposed to the Govt. which are the projects on gardens of Burhanpur, zooplanktons in river Tapti and plant Bar-coding in college campus.

- Green Projects

The college has developed green belt, botanical garden, green audit and vermicomposting unit. The College has complete Wi-Fi system. Work on green house, poly house, butterfly garden, water management & recycling, noise pollution control unit, energy conservation, polythene cleanliness drive are in progress. The staff & students downloaded the 'vayudoot' app & planted plants & sent photos. Green audit was done, in which 267 plants were included. The students attended camps on voter awareness, covid-19, health checkup, anemia, aids, diabetes, and nutrition in women, gender equality and women's rights.

- PG Internship

The students completed their PG Botany & Chemistry projects/ Internship/ mono graphic studies from sugar industry, PVC Pipes industry, soap manufacturing plant, Sachi Milk Dairy, Agricultural Deptt. Educational institutions, forest nursery, silvi culture, child welfare department, pharmacy etc.

- Academic performance

The results of all the classes were 100%.

The college campus was sanitized properly & regularly, so that it remained corona-free. The slogan "Yuva shakti-corona mukti" was implemented.

Despite Covid constraints Manuscript magazine (4) was inaugurated. The half yearly newsletters (7th and 8th) were also inaugurated.

- Research & Faculty improvement

The paper work under AISHE & RUSA has been completed. One faculty member has completed Ph.D. in botany and three faculty members have registered for Ph.D. in home science, commerce and microbiology dept. The research paper of one faculty member was published on National level international level & UGC.

- Conclusion

The college is an example of communal harmony under the Quaderia cultural and Educational society Burhanpur and S.G.J. Quaderia College with full co-operation from management, secretary Hon'ble Ali Asghar Takliwala, Hon'ble director Prof. M. H. Saleem, NAAC Co-ordinator and Prof. (Dr.) Smt. Rajkumari George.
